Ron Hockwalt Educational Scholarship Award

- The student must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5.
- > The student must be currently enrolled in the WVUSD for a minimum of three (3) years.
- Scholarship Award Application must be completed by the applicant and signed by the GLC or Principal. (E-signatures on emailed applications will be acceptable)
- The student must have demonstrated active participation in tutoring or mentorship in the educational field in the high school setting or in a local community organization(s).
- The key elements in the selection will include the length of participation in tutoring, the level and type of mentorship in the educational field, accomplishments, letter of recommendation, personal resume, and personal essay.

Ronald "Ron" Everett Servant Leader Scholarship Award

- > The student must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5.
- > The student must be currently enrolled in the WVUSD for a minimum of three (3) years.
- Scholarship Award Application must be completed by the applicant and signed by the GLC or Principal. (E-signatures on emailed applications will be acceptable)
- Student whose life is characterized by putting others above themselves and is manifested by service to school, community, and family.
- Student whose character is authentic and strives to live a life marked by integrity.
- Letter of recommendation from school representative as well as an individual within the community, personal essay which includes a powerful life lesson they learned while in school.

Teen Citizen Scholarship Award

- > The student must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5.
- > The student must be currently enrolled in the WVUSD for a minimum of three (3) years.
- Scholarship Award Application must be completed by the applicant and signed by the GLC or Principal. (E-signatures on emailed applications will be acceptable)
- The student must have demonstrated exemplary citizenship, active participation and accomplishments in a high school organization(s).
- The key elements in the selection will include the length and level/type of participation in the organization(s), accomplishments, letter of recommendation, personal resume, and personal essay.

Visual and Performing Arts Scholarship Award

- > The student must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5.
- > The student must be currently enrolled in the WVUSD for a minimum of three (3) years.
- Scholarship Award Application must be completed by the applicant and signed by the GLC or Principal. (E-signatures on emailed applications will be acceptable)
- The student must have demonstrated exemplary performance in Fine Arts in one or more of the following areas: Art, Dance, Vocal or Instrumental Music, Band, Drama, Film, Theater Arts.
- The key elements in the selection will include the student's accomplishments, letter of recommendation, personal resume, and personal essay.

Industrial Technology Scholarship Award

- > The student must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5.
- > The student must be currently enrolled in the WVUSD for a minimum of three (3) years.
- Scholarship Award Application must be completed by the applicant and signed by the GLC or Principal. (E-signatures on emailed applications will be acceptable)
- The accomplishments in Industrial Technology must be in one or more of the following areas: Drafting, Technology, Advanced Technology, Publications, Business, Automotive, CAD/CAM, and Graphic Design.
- The key elements in the selection will include the student's accomplishments, letter of recommendation, personal resume, and personal essay.
